## Project Description and Purpose:

- Resurface/reconstruct Hwy 212 pavement to restore structure and provide a smoother ride
- New traffic signals, turn lanes and American Disability Act (ADA) upgrades at Reform St. and Faxon Rd. intersections
- Construct Reduced Conflict Intersections (RCI) at CSAH 34/Tacoma Ave. and Morse St.
- Construct pedestrian underpass between Morse St. and Reform St. to safely cross Hwy 212
- Construct roundabout at Hwy 5/25/CSAH 33

# Overall Project Schedule

Project advertised on Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020

Bid letting on Friday, April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2020

Virtual Open House on May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2020, ongoing work with businesses

Construction starts when contract is awarded in mid-late June

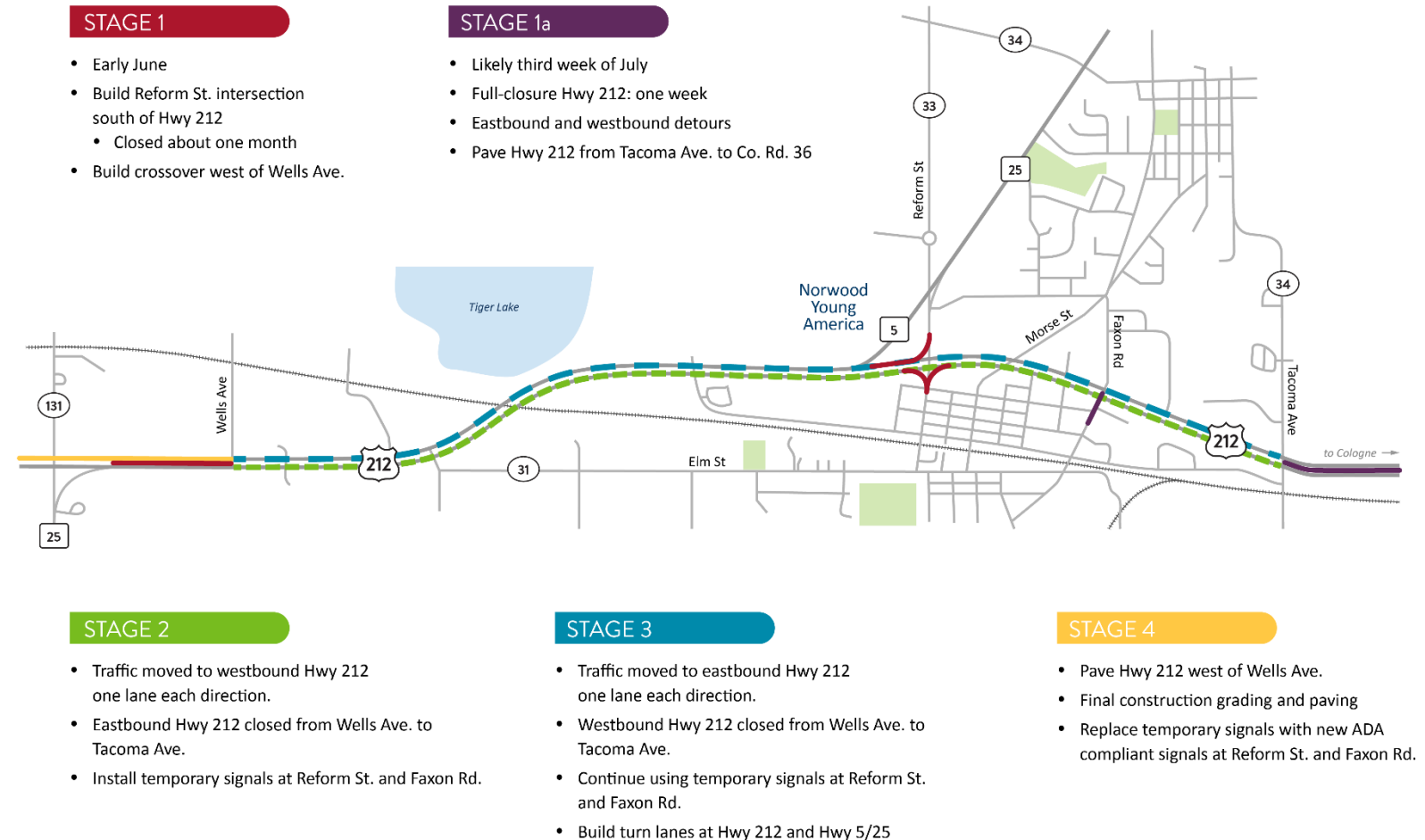
Planning to substantially complete project in 2020, unless:

- Delays due to COVID-19
- Extensive weather delays
- Encounter unforeseen conditions or materials

Contract will remain open into 2021 for seeding establishment, possibly some permanent striping, etc.

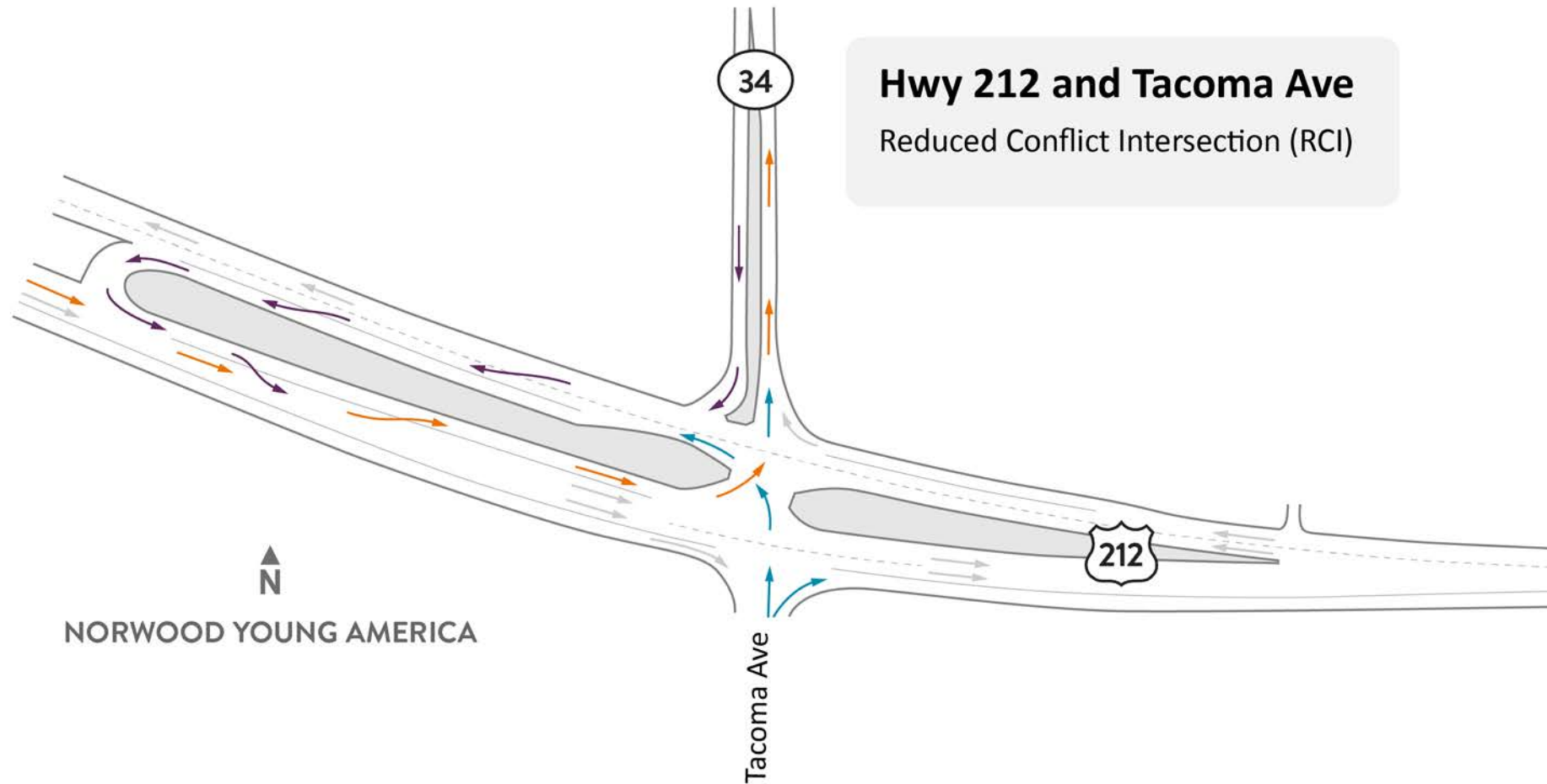

Project area

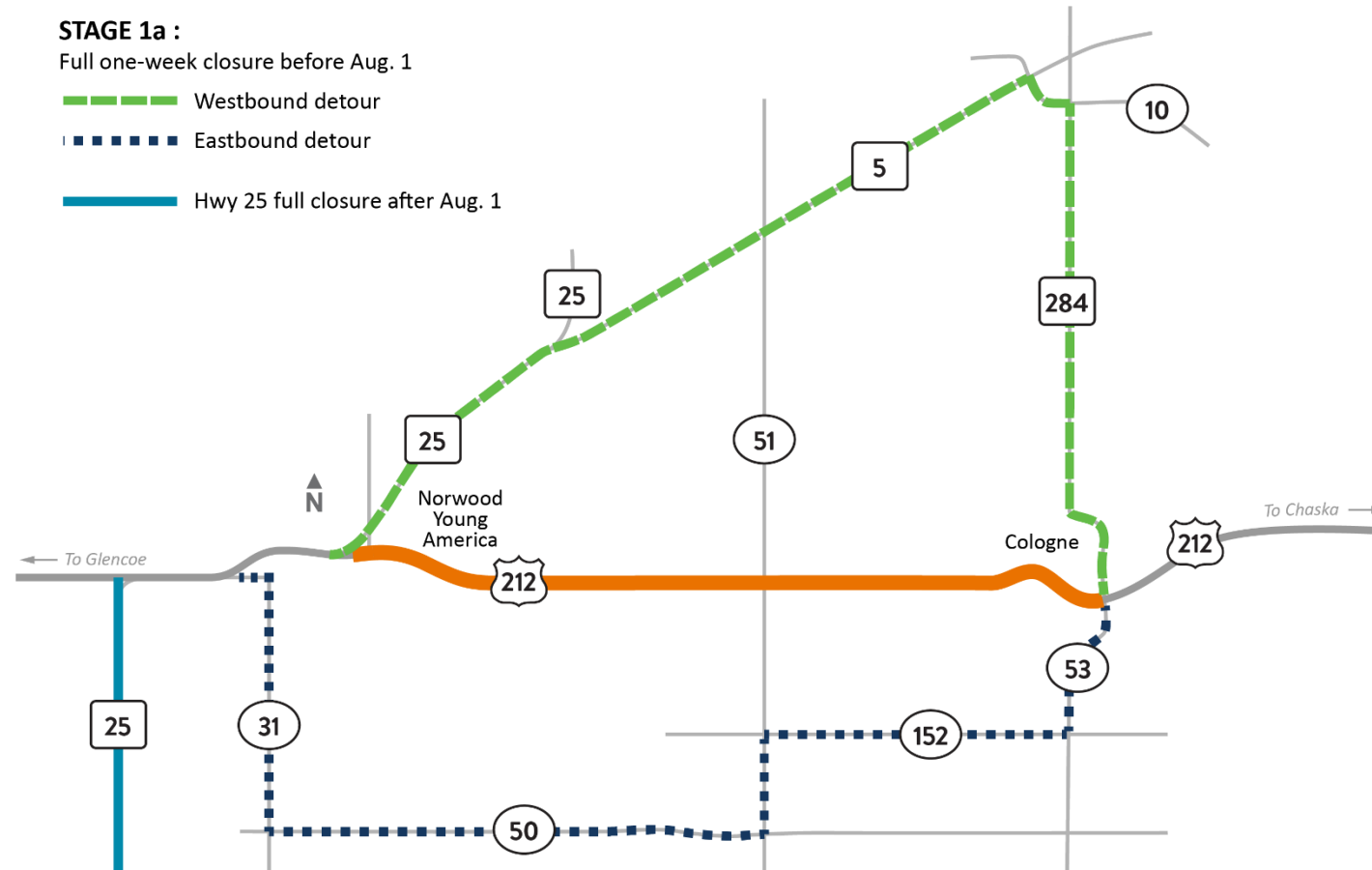

Full one-week closure before Aug. 1

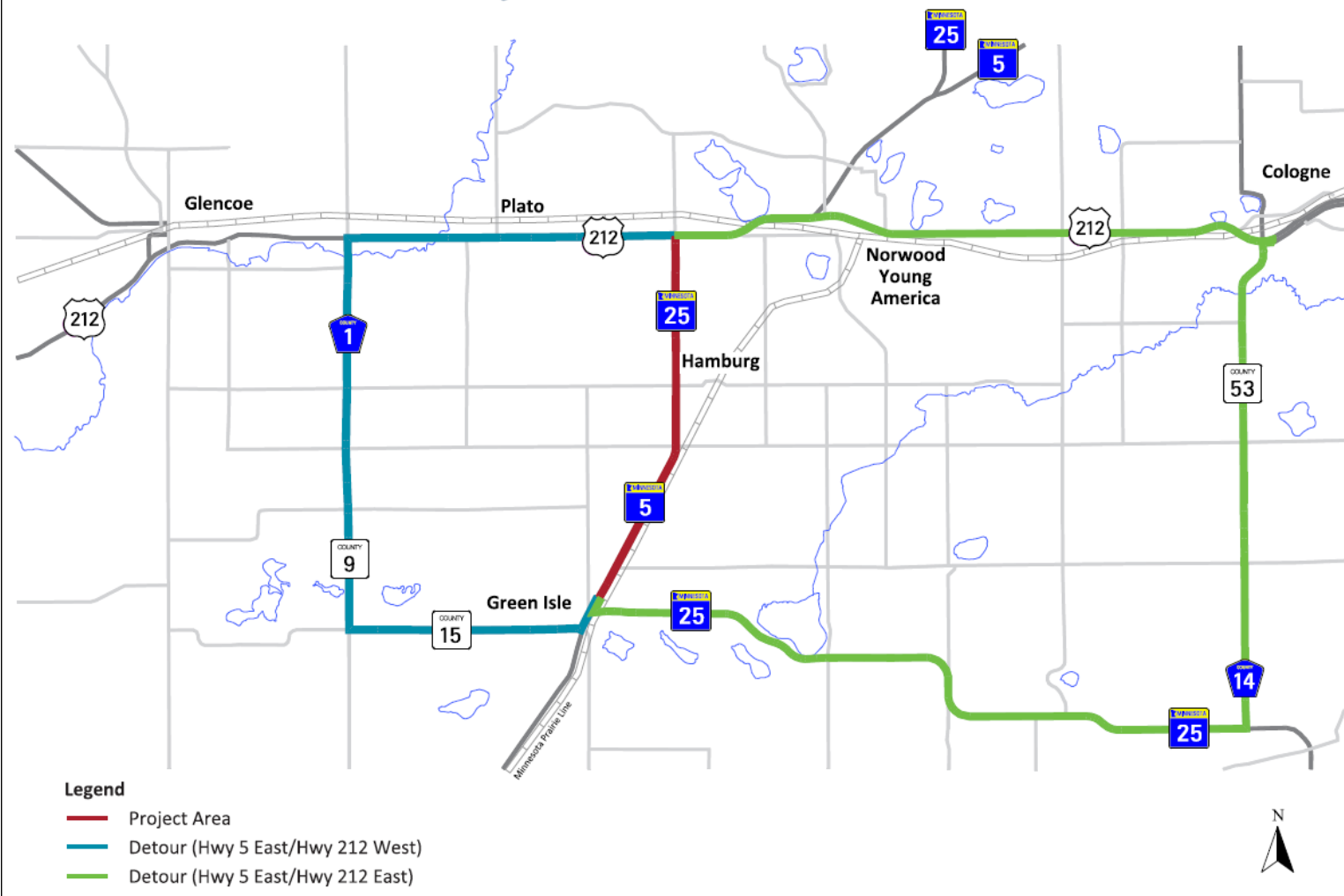
Westbound detour

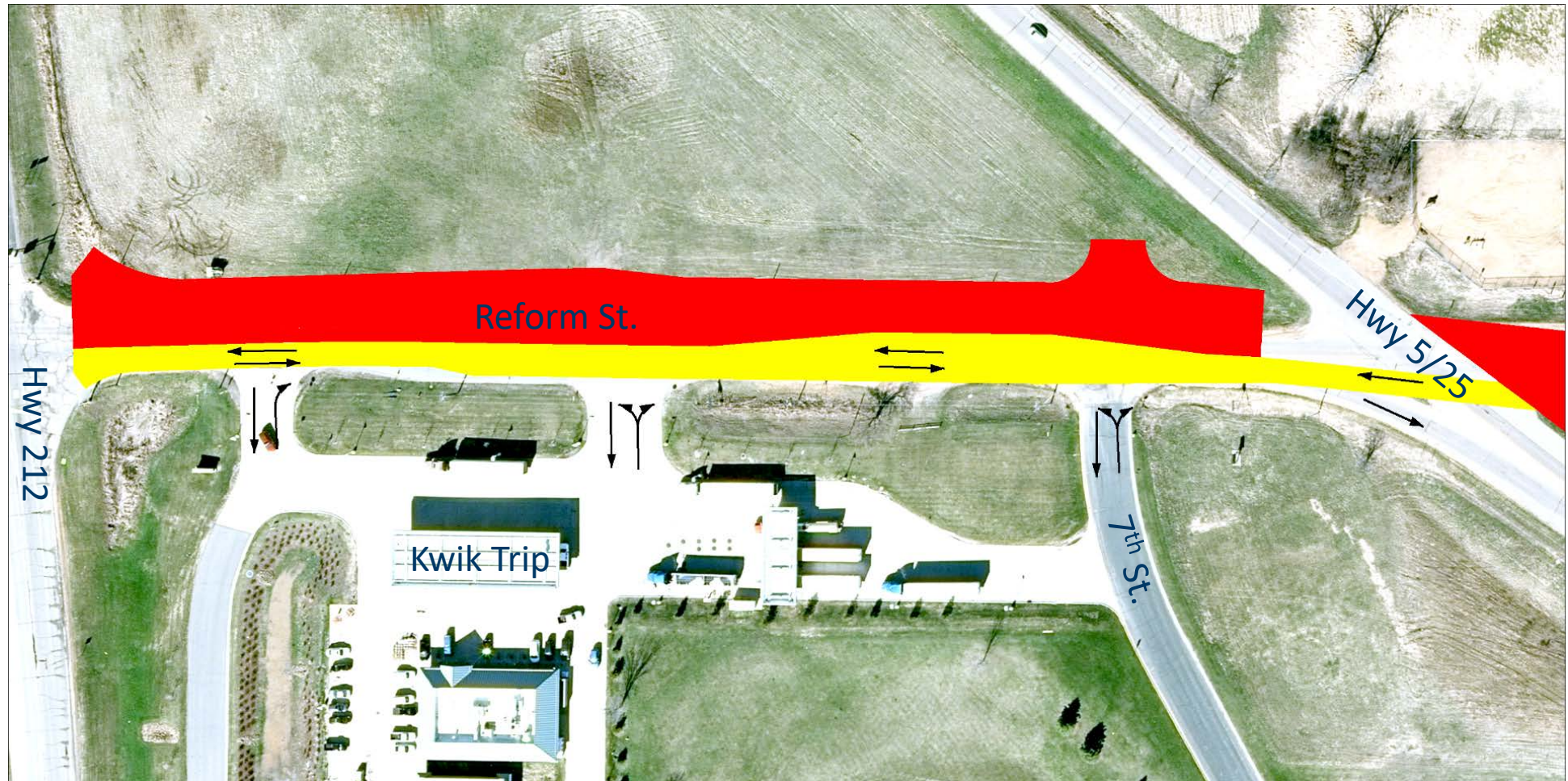

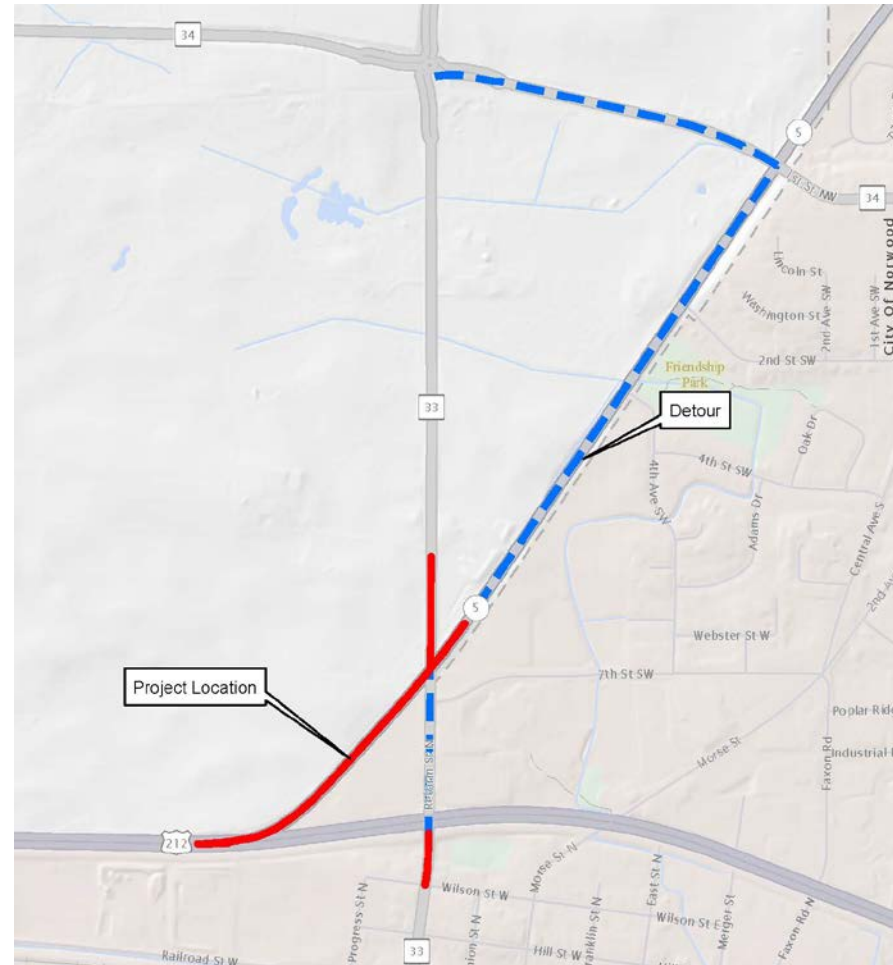

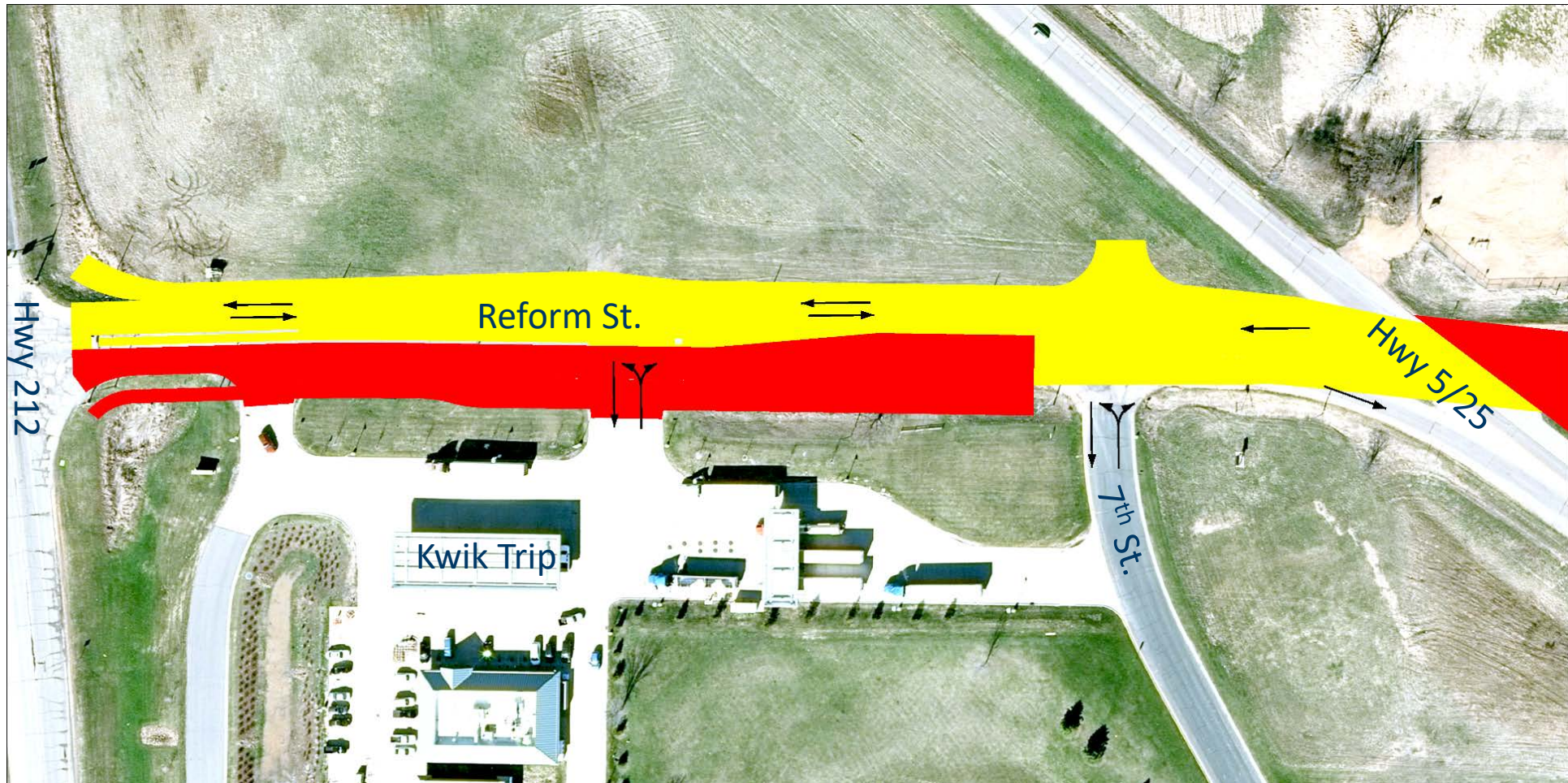


# Hwy 33 Detour Stages 1-4B



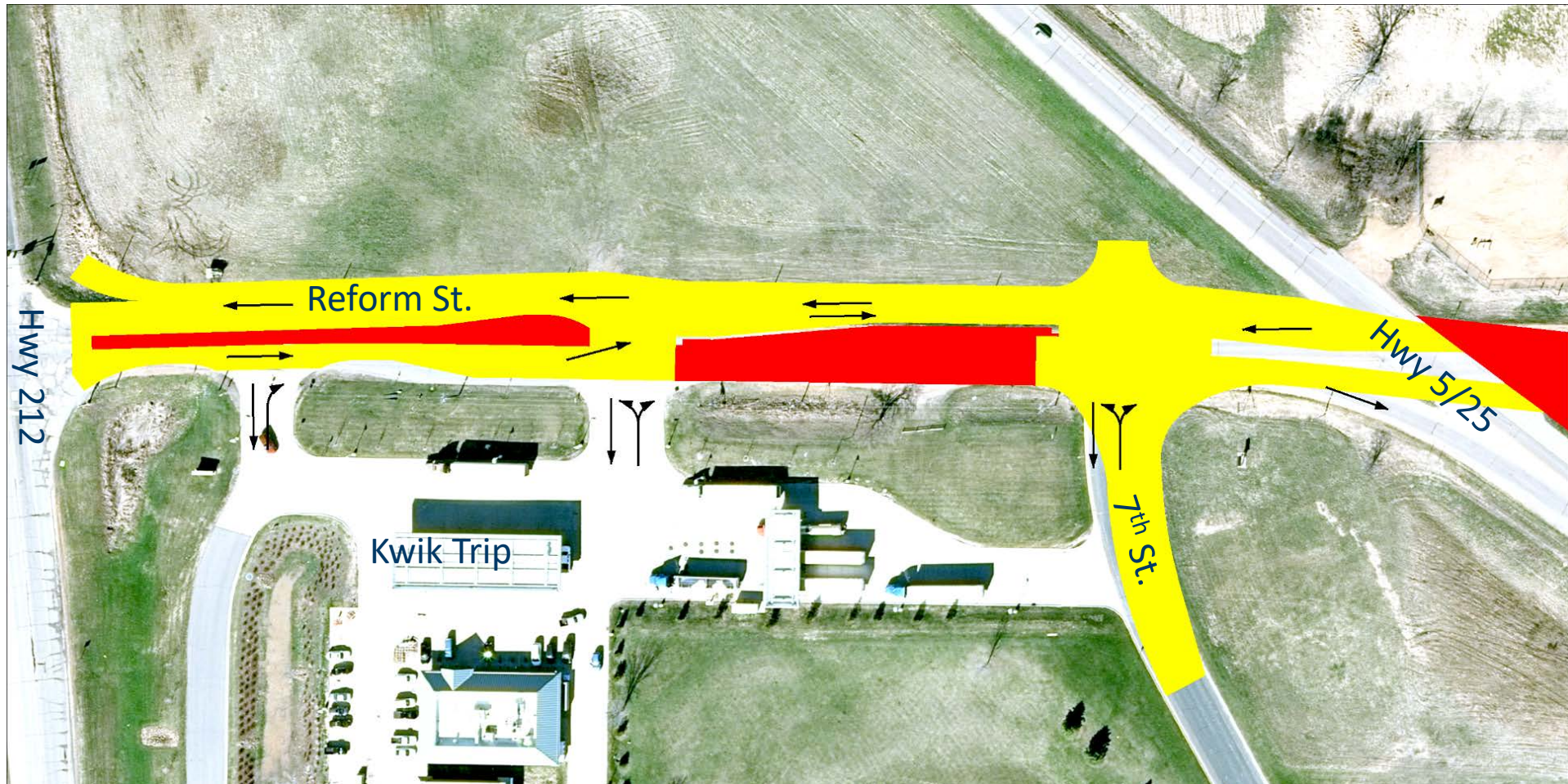

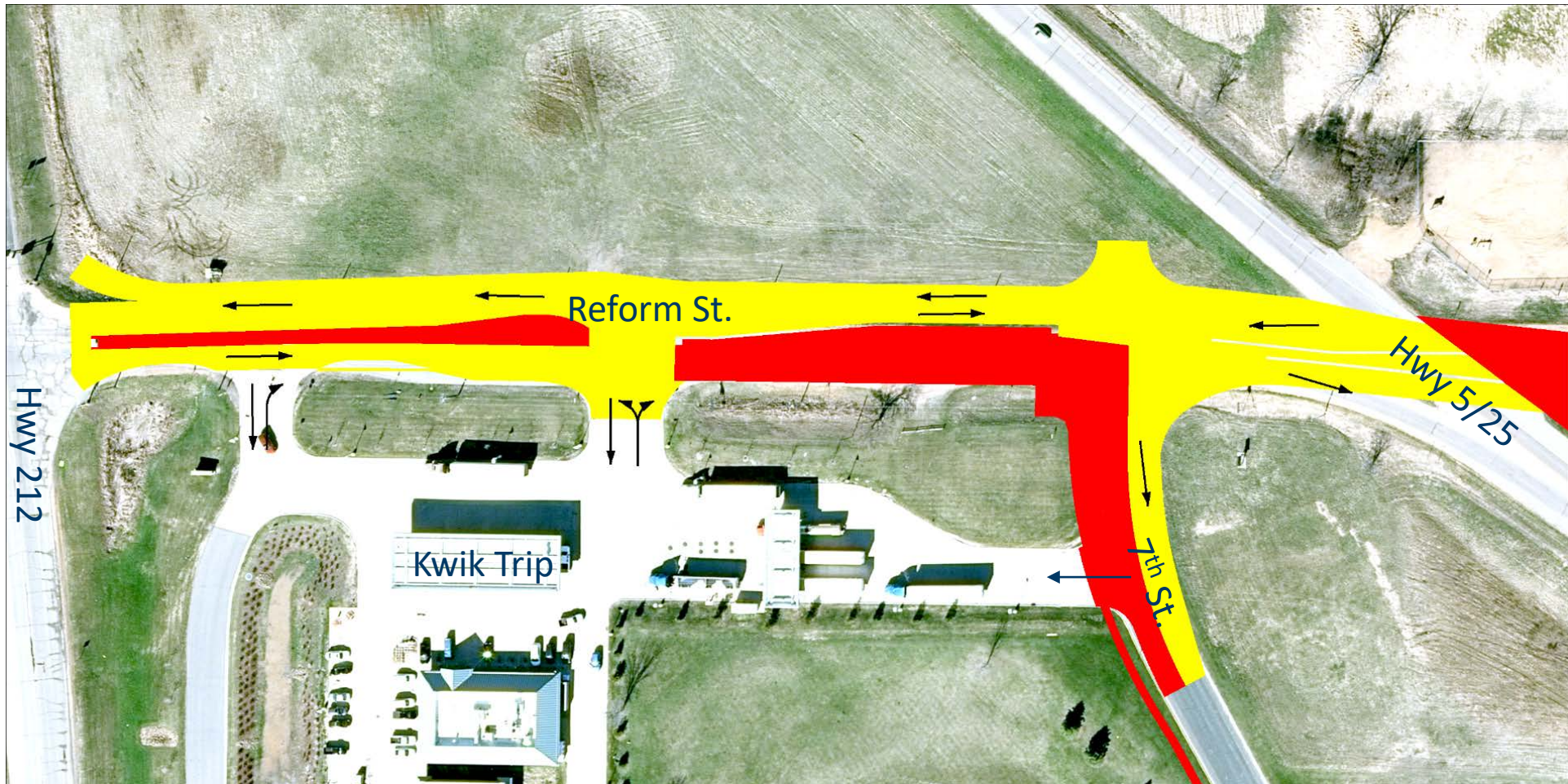

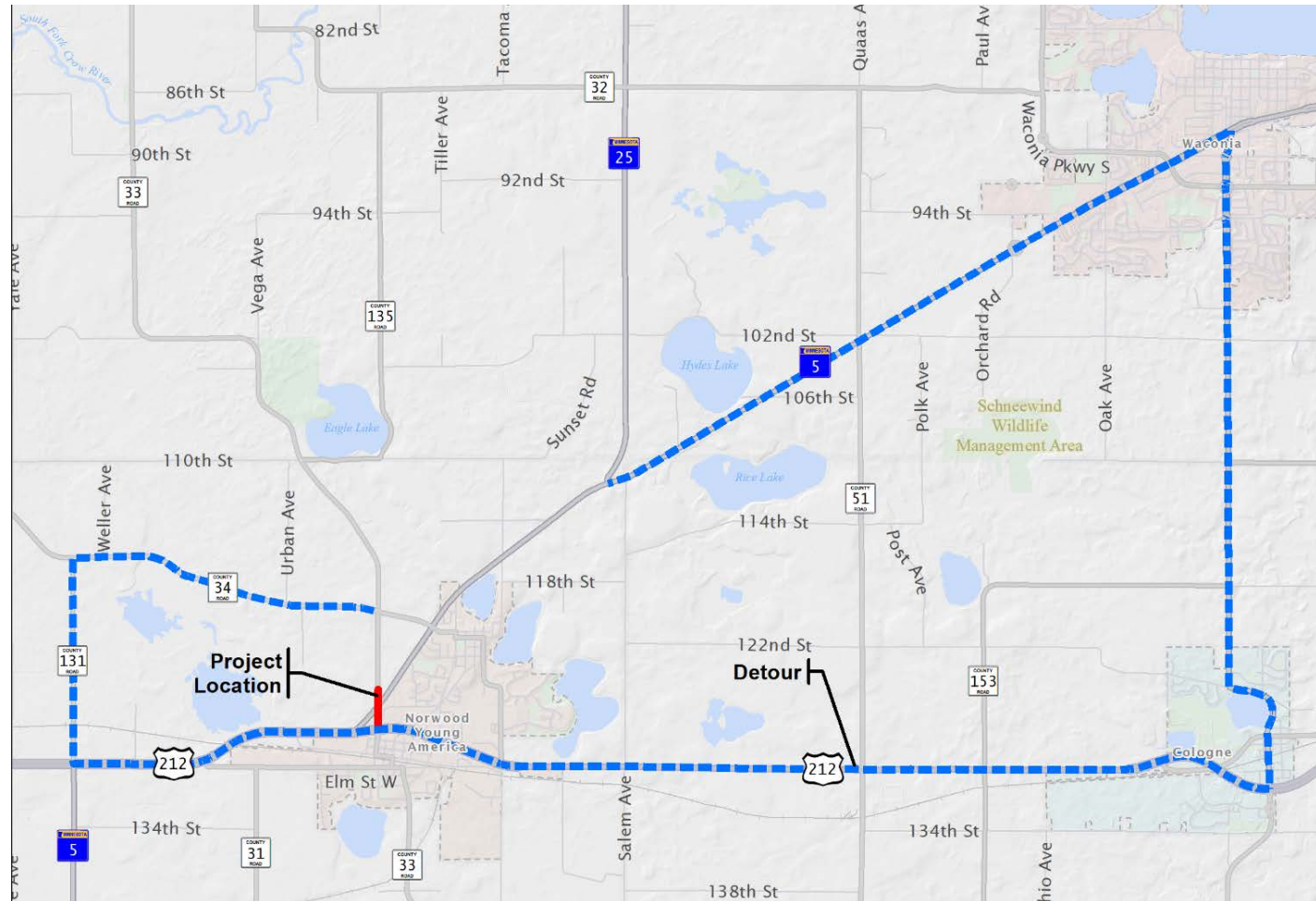

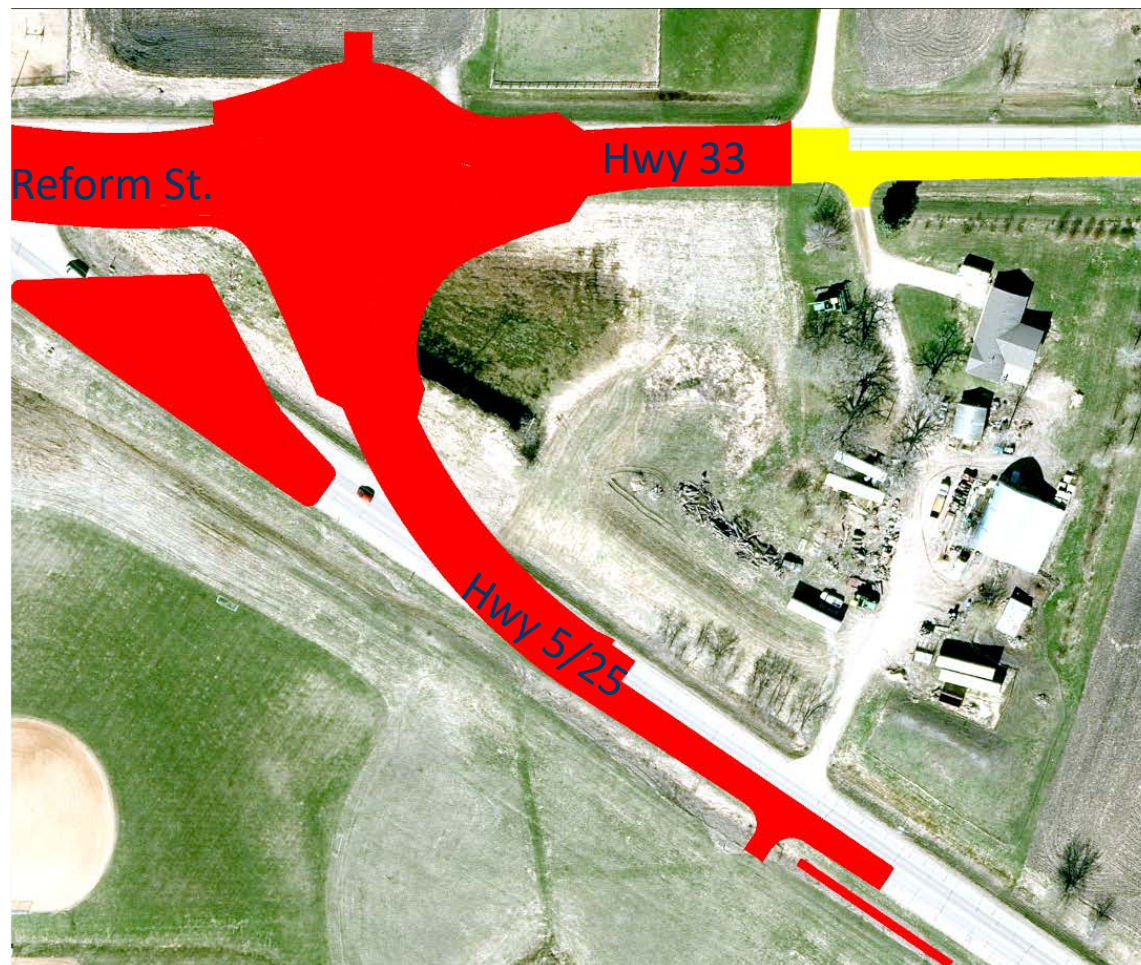
